Send a letter to the ASWCD (P.O. Box 26 Council, Idaho 83612)) or email it to aswd@ctcweb.net with the following information **by April 8, 2020.**

- Your name and age
- Your mailing address
- What school you attend
- Paragraph describing why you want to attend the Natural Resource Camp

The ASWCD will award 2 scholarships to Adams County students to cover the \$260 cost for each camper. If you are awarded the scholarship, the ASWCD board members would like you to attend a Board meeting in July or August 2020 and share what you did at the camp and what you learned.

University of Idaho Natural Resource Camp Information

- Why participate?
 - The camp is held in the beautiful Sawtooth National Recreation Area, one of our nation's premier backcountry playgrounds. You will stay in rustic cabins, eat at in a historic log lodge, and meet new friends. You will also learn about Idaho's magnificent natural resources and spend time in the forests and meadows of the dazzling Boulder Mountains.
- Who can attend?
 - 12 to 15 year old students who want to learn about our natural environment, how to protect it, and use it wisely.
- Dates:
 - Camp starts at 12:30 p.m. on Monday, June 22, 2020 goes until 10 a.m. to Saturday, June 27, 2020 MDT.
- Location:
 - Central Idaho 4-H Camp, Ketchum, Idaho. The camp entrance is 17 miles north of Ketchum on Highway 75 at signpost 146. Follow the road approximately 1.2 miles into camp.
